

# **Chess Adventures “BUGHOUSE” Chess Tournament**

**Saturday October 12, 2019**

**DIVISIONS:** Grades K, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 Students must be currently registered and enrolled in the Church Chess or Chess Adventures Program to play. This is a non-rated tournament. Similar age groups may be combined. USCF rules will apply. **THIS IS A TEAM TOURNAMENT. TWO PEOPLE PER TEAM.**

**ENTRY FEE:** \$25.00 per child. Money and registration MUST be received via online payment by Friday October 11, 2019. **There will be no onsite registration.** Payment confirmation email will be sent.

**TIMES:** Check in is 9:00am to 9:45am. The Player Meeting is at 9:45a.m. (All competitors must attend). Round 1 begins at 10:00am. Each round will take approximately twenty minutes. There will be no scheduled breaks, light concessions will be provided. Players are advised to bring their own sack lunch and snacks to eat in between rounds. This is a 5-round, **non-elimination** tournament - players should plan to participate in all five rounds. The tournament should end around 10:00am-1:00pm.

**TIME CONTROL:** Time control is G-05;D-0 (10 minutes, per player, per game). A clock will be placed on each board, with each player getting 10 minutes per side. Most of the children are not experienced with chess clocks. We will explain how to use the clock to the children, as needed.

**PRIZES:** Six individual top place trophies will be given to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place individual winners. Participation awards will be given to non-trophy winners. Awards ceremony will follow the final round and will occur mid-late afternoon, after Round 5 is completed.

**LOCATION:** **Hopewell Missionary Baptist Church** 182 Hunter St. NW Norcross, GA. 30071

(Tournament will be held in **Faith Hall**)

**SUPERVISION:** Good behavior of all participants is expected. However, all players 12 years old and younger must have a parent/guardian present for the entire tournament. While parents are not allowed in the competition area once a round begins, parents are required to supervise their children between each round. If it becomes clear a child does not have supervision between rounds, he/she will forfeit the opportunity and a parent or guardian will be contacted. **Parents are not to drop off their children for the day and leave them unattended. Parents will NOT be able to see students during matches.**
